REGISTRATION

hanks to all those players who have registered. Most of this fee goes to registering each player with the Camogie Association and on insurance. Both of these are required to play for the Rocks! For our new players and those needing to register, registration forms can be downloaded from our website, www.arklowrocks.com or from anyone of the coaches.

SUBS

hanks to everyone who has been paying their subs regularly. This vital money is essential to cover the cost of our Camogie teams. Each match/blitz costs €15/€10 per team. We also have bought equipment to enable our teams to train. Sliotars cost €5 each! And then there are the well deserved treats. All these expenses add up, to date we have collected €342 in subs and paid out €333

Instead of being taken weekly, the subs will be collected on the first Saturday of each month. This cuts down on the administration time and gives us more time for the actual game. We will send a reminder on our WhatsApp groups.


