YOUNG PLAYERS SHOULD ALWAYS:

- Play fairly, do their best and enjoy themselves.
- Respect fellow team members regardless of ability, cultural or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation or religion beliefs.
- Support fellow team members regardless of whether they do well or not.
- Represent their team, their Club and their family with pride and dignity.
- Respect all coaches, officials and their opponents.
- Be gracious in defeat and modest in victory.
- Shake hands before and after a game as part of the Give Respect Get Respect initiative, irrespective of the result.
- Inform their Coach/Mentor/Manager in advance if they are unavailable for training and games.
- Take due care of Club equipment.
- Know that it is acceptable to talk to the Club Children's Officer with any concerns or questions they may have.
- Adhere to acceptable standards of behaviour and their Club's Code of Discipline.
- Tell somebody else if they or others have been harmed in any way

YOUNG PLAYERS SHOULD NEVER:

- Cheat – always play by the rules.
- Shout at or argue with a game's official, with their Coach, their team mates or opponents and should never use violence.
- Use unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage or isolate other players.
- Spread rumours.
- Tell lies about adults or other young people.
- Play or train if they feel unwell or are injured.
- Use unacceptable language or racial and/or sectarian references.

GUILDINE FOR PARENTS

- Be a positive role model for your child and maintain the highest standards of conduct when interacting with children.
- Respect officials' decisions and encourage children to do likewise. Do not publicly question the judgement or honesty of referees or sports leaders.
- Do not exert undue pressure on your child.
- Never admonish your own child or any other child for their standard of play.
- Always recognise the value and importance of the volunteers who provide sporting/recreational opportunities for your child
- Show approval for effort, not just results.
- Avoid asking a child or young person, 'How much did you score today' or 'What did you win by'.' Ask them 'Did they enjoy themselves.'
- Never embarrass a child or use sarcastic remarks towards a player.
- Set a good example by applauding good play from all teams.
- Parents should support all efforts to remove abusive and bullying behaviour in all its forms
- Do not seek to unfairly affect a game or player.
- Do not enter the field of play unless specifically invited to do so by an official in charge.
- Sign up to the Code of Ethics and Good Practice for Young People in GAA/Cumann Camógaíochta na nGael.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1 I will respect the rules and procedures set down in GAA/ Cumann Camógaíochta na nGael's Code of Ethics for Young People in Sport.
- 2 I will respect my child's leaders (e.g. managers, coaches, and officials), team mates and their parents, as well as players, parents and coaches from opposing teams. I will encourage my child to treat other participants, coaches, selectors and managers with respect.
- 3 I will give encouragement and applaud only positive accomplishments whether from my child, team mates, their opponents or the officials.
- 4 I will respect the officials and their authority during matches.
- 5 I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behaviour or use foul language.
