FOIREANN USER GUIDE

The GAA has introduced a new complete Games Management System, called **Foireann**, which is Irish for Team. This is a development from last year's Return To Play system.

Foireann introduces new features for Clubs and Members including:

- ✓ Easy online registration
- ✓ Online payment option for individuals and families
- ✓ Streamlined and secure communications
- ✓ Team management system for coaches

Players of all ages will need to registered on Foireann to complete Health questionnaires when play resumes.

<p>Step 1. Create & log into your Foireann Account</p>	<p>Members who set up a ReturnToPlay account in 2019 to complete Health Questionnaires can access their Foireann account by using the same login id and password.</p> <p>Don't have a ReturnToPlay account? You can easily register a new account at www.foireann.ie. Just follow the instructions for New user? Register</p> <p>Once logged in complete your Profile details.</p>
<p>Step 2. Create a Family and Add family members</p>	<p>Creating a Family allows you to affiliate all members of the family under one family grouping providing you with the functionality to link your children/dependents and additional people such as grandparents, siblings, adult children to your Foireann account.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Navigate to the 'Family' section on the menu▪ Click the 'Add New Family' button▪ Enter your family name and description and save <p>To Add another Parent/Guardian – click  and enter all details as required</p> <p>To Add Children – click  and enter all details as required</p>
<p>Step 3. Register Family members for 2021</p>	<p>Once your family is set up they should appear on your Home page. To register for the coming season:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Navigate to the Membership section.▪ Select Membership Options. From this page select the membership you require by clicking Register. Select the name of the person(s) being registered from the dropdown menu.
